


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| <p style="text-align: center;">3-2-1 Summary</p> <p>Write a summary of the topic using this strategy.</p> <p>You should:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In the bottom three spaces, write three important facts • In the middle two spaces, define or identify two important processes, people or structures • In the top space, write one question that can be answered using the other two levels  | <p style="text-align: center;">Acrostic Poem</p> <p>Choose a term, process or main idea on the topic to create an acrostic poem.</p> <p>You should:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Write the term down the left hand side of your paper. • Write a complete thought about the subject for each letter (not just a single word) • Include a colored picture | <p style="text-align: center;">Be the Thing</p> <p>Write a short personal response as if you were a specific object from an event.</p> <p>Your response should:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be at least 10 sentences • Describe how the object might feel or what it might be thinking about the event • Include six facts about the event from the object's point of view |
| <p style="text-align: center;">Boardgame</p> <p>Create a mini-board game.</p> <p>You should include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A sketch of a miniature version of the board • The rules for playing • 10 cards to use in the game, with questions & answers | <p style="text-align: center;">Brochure</p> <p>Create an informational brochure.</p> <p>You should:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Trifold a piece of blank paper • Include a cover with a title and a picture • Summarize the important ideas on the topic • Include pictures, in color | <p style="text-align: center;">CD label</p> <p>Create a CD label (cover & back with song list) highlighting the main ideas.</p> <p>You should include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A fictional band name & cover art • 10 track titles highlighting the main ideas of the topic |

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| <p style="text-align: center;">Children's Book</p> <p>Write & illustrate a short, 5-page children's booklet.</p> <p>You should include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • a cover with the title and a picture • a basic summary of the topic, in terms which a child can understand • five pages with a short amount of text and pictures, in color | <p style="text-align: center;">Cinquains</p> <p>Choose any two main ideas about the topic and write a cinquain about each.</p> <p>You should follow this format:</p> <p>Line 1 = one word (the subject) Line 2 = two words that describe Line 3 = three action words about what the subject does Line 4 = four or five word phrase describing the subject Line 5 = one word that could be another name for the subject</p> | <p style="text-align: center;">Collage</p> <p>Create a picture from pieces of paper and pictures, to create an image that is representative of an idea or topic that you've been assigned.</p> <p>Source of pictures:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Magazines • Newspapers • Internet • Clipart • Hand Drawn |
| <p style="text-align: center;">Comic Book</p> <p>Determine the 8 most important events/topics and create an illustrated summary.</p> <p>You should:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Divide your notebook page into 8 sections • Dedicate one panel per main idea • At the bottom of each box write your caption <p>Illustrations for each panel should be meaningful and colorful</p> | <p style="text-align: center;">Concept Map</p> <p>Create an illustrated concept map.</p> <p>You should:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Write the main idea in the center & add topics connected to the main idea • For each topic: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ include at least 2 supporting details ○ Include at least 1 illustration <p>Use a different color for each topic.</p> | <p style="text-align: center;">Crossword Puzzle</p> <p>Create a crossword puzzle using important concepts, terms & events on this topic.</p> <p>You should:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Choose ten concepts, terms or events • Copy the puzzle onto your page, writing the words in crisscross combinations • Write a clue for each of your ten • items under "across" or "down headings |

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| <p style="text-align: center;">Haiku</p> <p>Write a series of three haikus to summarize your topic.</p> <p>You should follow this format:</p> <p>Line 1 = phrase containing 5 syllables Line 2 = phrase containing 7 syllables Line 3 = phrase containing 5 Syllables</p> | <p style="text-align: center;">Illustration</p> <p>Create a picture and write about it.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Draw a picture that illustrates a relationship between the vocabulary and the learning target. • Explain in one paragraph your visual representation. | <p style="text-align: center;">Illustrated Outline</p> <p>Create an illustrated outline.</p> <p>You should:</p> <p>Choose 3-5 main ideas on the topic</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Turn your notebook sideways. • Starting at the margin, separate the page into columns based on the number of main ideas • Write the topic at the top of each column • Take at least three bulleted notes under each main idea • Draw one picture for each main idea |
| <p style="text-align: center;">KIM Charts</p> <p>Define & illustrate important ideas so that you can remember them.</p> <p>You should:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Choose at least four main ideas on the topic • Divide notebook page into three columns • Write the main idea in the left column • Write the information that goes along with it in the center column • Draw a colored picture of the idea (a memory clue) in the right column | <p style="text-align: center;">Letter</p> <p>Write a letter from a famous scientist connected to the topic.</p> <p>You should include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dear _____, • At least three paragraphs explaining the topic • A signature and a date | <p style="text-align: center;">Magazine Cover</p> <p>Create a news magazine cover.</p> <p>You should include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Magazine title • A central, important image • At least 3 news story leads <p>The final results should look clean and artistic like a magazine cover (block letters, quality artwork, headlines, etc.).</p> |

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| <p style="text-align: center;">Muddy Moment</p> <p>What frustrates and confuses you about the text? Why?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Write about anything that originally confused you but now understand. • Explain why it was confusing. | <p style="text-align: center;">Newspaper Article</p> <p>Write a newspaper article about your topic as if you were there.</p> <p>You should include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A headline (short & to the point) • 2-3 paragraphs that explain the event (who, what, where, when, how & why) • A color "photograph" with a caption (may be drawn or taken from the internet). | <p style="text-align: center;">Outline</p> <p>Create an outline to demonstrate your knowledge of the learning target.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The learning target <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Fact 1 <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. Supporting detail ii. Supporting detail b. Fact 2 <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. | <p style="text-align: center;">Ring of Truth</p> <p>Reflect on what you have learned on this topic.</p> <p>You should:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Draw two circles, a smaller circle inside of a larger circle • In the inner circle, write the main idea • In the outer circle, list specific facts, ideas and information about the main idea • In the area outside of the circles, write down common misconceptions that a person might have about the main idea • Below the Ring of Truth, explain why these misconceptions are wrong and why people might have them | <p style="text-align: center;">Self Reflection</p> <p>Reflect on what you have learned on this topic.</p> <p>You should:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Write at least three paragraphs • Include what you knew about the topic before we studied it in class • Include what you have learned about the topic • Include the ways in which your attitude to the topic might have changed | <p style="text-align: center;">Study Guide</p> <p>Create a study guide that outlines main ideas.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Write at least ten questions that could be on a study guide to reinforce the learning target • Include the answers |

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| <p style="text-align: center;">Song Rewrite</p> <p>Take any song & rewrite the lyrics to include information about a topic.</p> <p>You should:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Include the name of the original song• Rewrite the lyrics to include at least six pieces of information about your topic• Write at least two verses & the chorus | <p style="text-align: center;">Top Ten</p> <p>Using humor, write about the most important big ideas related to the learning target.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Remember, it's supposed to be funny, but shows you understand.</i></p> | <p style="text-align: center;">Venn Diagram</p> <p>Complete a comparing/ contrasting chart.</p> <p>You should:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Draw two circles that intersect• Write the name of one main idea on one circle and a second main idea on the other circle• List at least five unique characteristics for each main idea• List at least two shared characteristics of the ideas in the intersection |
| <p style="text-align: center;">Visual Summary</p> <p>Create a visual summary of your topic.</p> <p>You should:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Write at least 5 main ideas and illustrate each one Pictures must have color! | <p style="text-align: center;">You be the Teacher!</p> <p>Create a quiz.</p> <p>You should:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Include at least 12 questions• Use multiple choice, matching, or fill in the blank (no True/False)• Focus on the most important ideas• Include an answer key | |
